“Forgotten Fire” is based on the true story of Adam Bagdasarian’s great-uncle during the Armenian Genocide of 1915. Baghdasarian uncle, Vahridj Kenderian recorded his experiences during the genocide, shortly before his death in America. À (librisnotes)
Forgotten Fire is one of the few books of historical fiction to have a truly credible source. And although the story told by Bagdasarian is not exactly that of his great uncle, he used enough precise details to share his story. The aspects of history that Bagdasarian changed were not enough to change the history of the Armenian genocide, but only the fictitious character that he had drawn from the tapes. For example, Bagdasarian kept the history of Istanbul true. “The survivors of the Armenian genocide are Western Armenians who were not killed in the genocide of 1915. Most of the survivors became refugees outside Turkey, the successor state of the Ottoman Empire. About 70,000 Armenians remain in Turkey, most of them in Istanbul.ÀeÀ~ (Wikipedia)
The fact that Istanbul was a constant city during the Armenian genocide is important. Constantinople is where many Armenian refugees, including Vahan and his sister in Forgotten Fire. While this is an important story, it could be more suitable for sophisticated teenagers and adults.
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
