Some people might have their social media profile set to private or might require you to connect with them on the service before you can view personal details like their phone number. Try adding other relevant details to the search to help narrow down the results. A simple search should be enough since phone numbers are unique to each owner, but if you also know where the person lives, where they work or went to school, what the company name is, the person's first or last name, etc., it could help locate the correct information. The search engine method above is useful for looking up cell phone numbers when you're not sure where exactly to search. However, if you didn't have luck with that method, there are sites made specifically for finding phone numbers and digging up who owns a number. While most number lookup services focus on landlines, these have been confirmed to work when you're looking up a name associated with the number, or for doing the opposite (locating a number from the person's name): Spy Dialer: See the owner's name and where the area code is from. You can also hear the person's voicemail message. NumLookup: View the person's name and which carrier the number currently belongs to.
