I don't like the fact that many of the features must be obtained by having a creative cloud account that is active... It is very intuiital for beginners, easy to use and simple software... These options are very important for all aspects of business, and it can become very irritating when you lose the license or don't have it... Zoom option is not enough user friendly for me... My overall experience using Adobe Acrobat Reader DC is great, as long as I have the license... There are many other PDF programs out there like Nitro, SourceForge that have many available features that are free, Adobe Acrobat should follow the example of these other pdf apps... If you use this product for business purposes, they are indispensable... However, I lately switched to modern PDF Solutions such as Foxit PDF editor and WPS Office Suite... The interface of this software is user friendly, I can find every in my hand when I use it... So, for instance, if you are using the free version, you get limited functionality e.g. editing PDF documents is not available in free version... Before Adobe Acrobat Reader DC was introduced editing PDF file was very difficult for me... Reduced Size PDF so useful when trying to compress files... I also do not like the GUI of Reader, it is too busy with options and makes a novice and even an advanced user very frustrated with features that arent readily available without using the paid for Software as a Service... The ease with which you can rearrange pages in a document, convert to word, rich text, excel, and other formats, sign and obtain signatures, apply security features like password protection, digital signatures, encryption and the like are robust feature-sets... Each time I get a new device - phone or PC, I ensure that Acrobat Reader DC is one of the first applications I install since its a handy tool for my day to day tasks... Combine files is not available with the basic account type... You can combine files from different formats into a pdf... Works well on mobiles too... Some premium features are available in the PRO version, for which you need to shell out a monthly subscription... Easy to use, well-priced, and multifunctional... it's a no-brainer to use it... This software is a tool for several aspects of my job... So, if you use these you will not have worries regarding formats etc as you can just open the document on any of the devices... It allows you to open various documents organised across tabs which you can navigate across... Given I have 32 GB of RAM, a 6 core 3.85 gigahertz processor and 1gb of dedicated VRAM I think the slowing down is a lack of efficiency in the code... It saves a lot of our time... Although it may not be the easiest tool to use, it remains very useful if you have the right knowledge and computing resources... Managing documents has never been easier... Easy of export to other formats... In addition, you can combine files and compress for ease of operating... I hate having to manually combine PDFs in the left pane... The inability to license it for a one time fee, there are only subscription models available... There may be times where you don't want to alter your source file, but you want to share a different version with others... I truly could not do my job as efficiently without it... Zoom feature is user-friendly and it's too easy for me to operate... In many cases, where we want to make a simple note is not possible, just using the highlighter is not enough, joining files is also not possible, so the software for me has become obsolete... In the past, when I work for too long, I forgot to save my works, sometimes software crashes... I can't imagine spending time manually inputting text fields onto a PDF file... I like that the product is free, easy to access from a deployment standpoint... Wish if some of the PRO features could be made available in the FREE version... I think Foxit reader is a great software but it is not as competent as Adobe Acrobat specially in handling multiple pdf files of big size... The feature that could be improved is the software update because you must have the latest version to be able to use it... My overall opinion is to purchase this product when it's a part of a bundle of other software... Document Cloud allows Acrobat Reader DC to integrate online and solve storage, mobility and logistics problems... I have also used Acrobat Reader DC when doing supplier and customer reconciliations where I just use the highlight function to mark those statement items I've reconciled already...
