
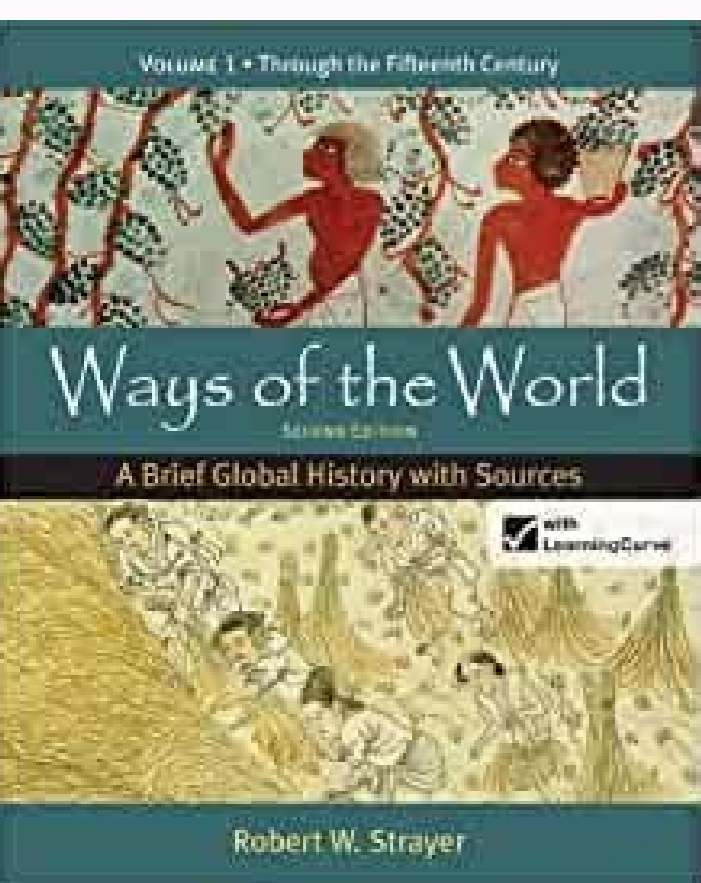
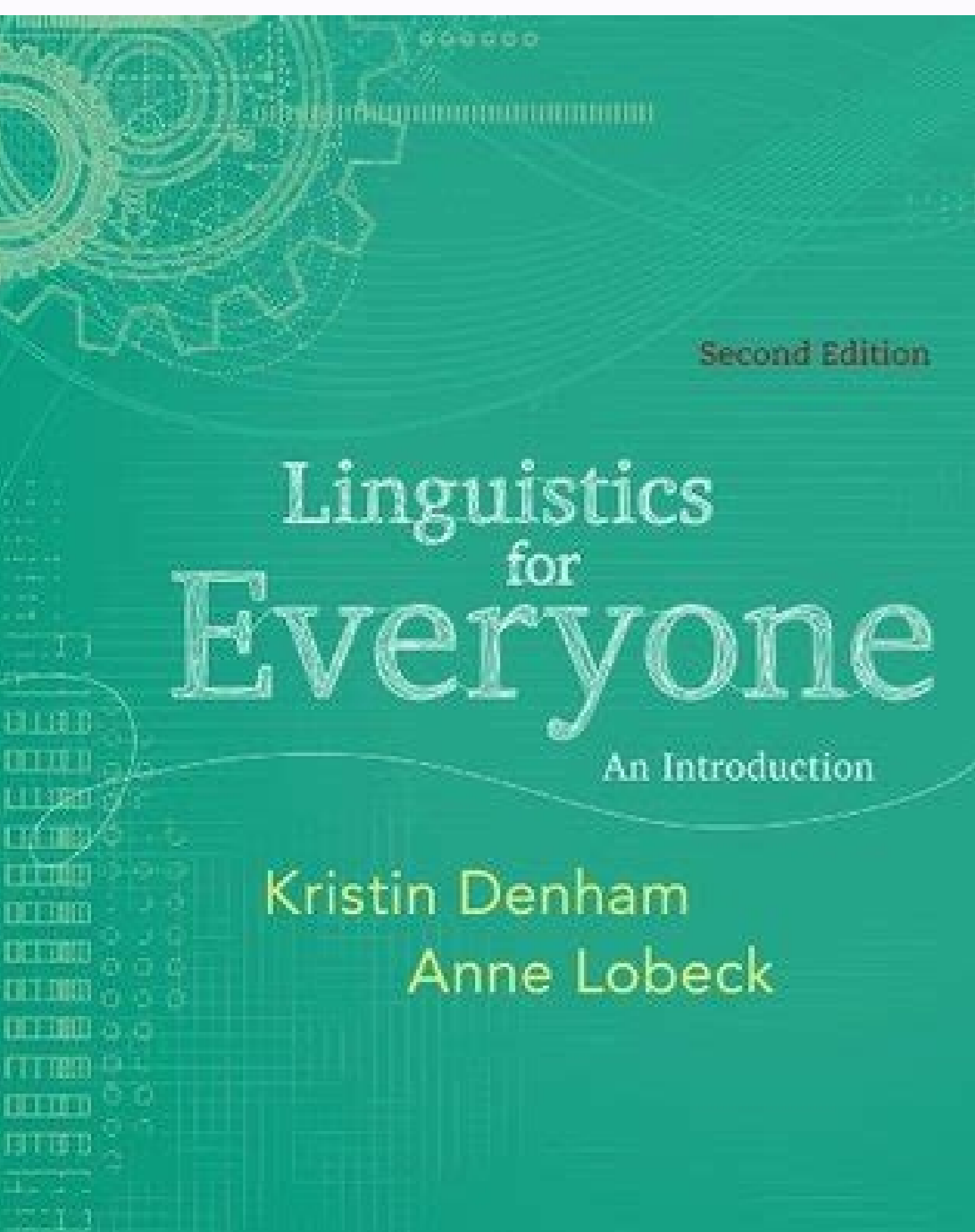
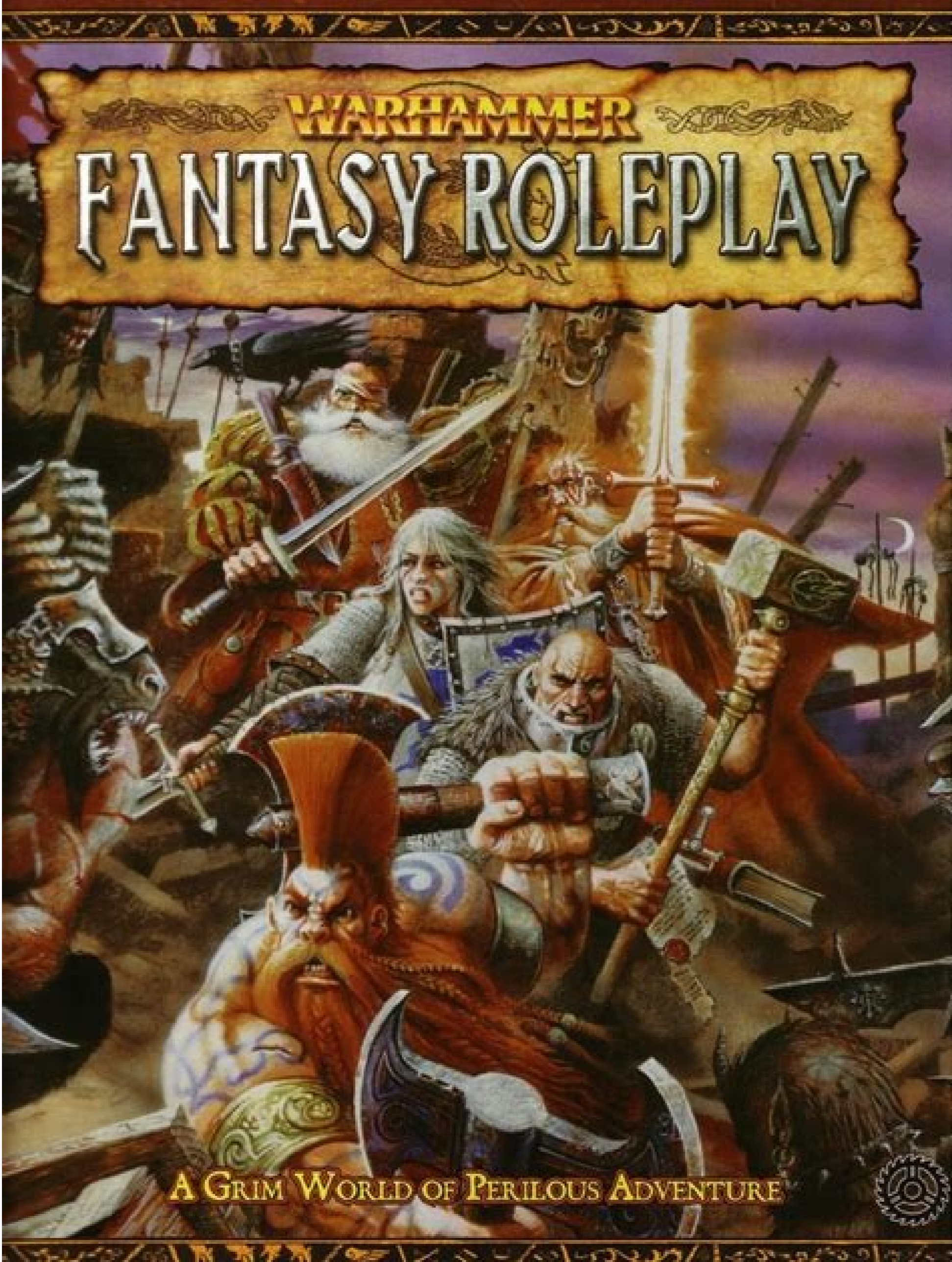

This iconic summer read perfectly captures the feeling of longing for someone and it features plentiful, engaging conversations, early morning swims, leisurely bike rides, a furtive relationship and a passionate trip to Rome. The Mexican Canadian author sets the action in 1970s Mexico City and writes about Maite, a secretary obsessed with romance stories and her beautiful neighbor Leonora. Of course, besides all the procrastinating and writing, there's also time for love. They both need to teach the other everything they need to know to be able to produce something in a genre they're not used to working in. Set in a small Michigan town, the novel tells the story of bestselling romance author January and acclaimed fiction writer Gus. There are plenty of descriptions of proper picnic attire, the landscape and the relationships that bond this group of teenagers and their teachers. Even if he's a sociopath with more than murderous tendencies, the reader can't avoid being on Ripley's side while reading Highsmith's engrossing novels. The action encompasses several decades starting in the 1950s and weaves together the life of the assimilated sister — who's leading a double life in New Orleans first and then Los Angeles — with that of the other one, who is forced to return home. Even if you don't like international thrillers featuring double agents that much — who doesn't though? The Brit Bennett-penned historical novel, which is already being developed into a limited series by HBO, tells the story of two identical twin sisters from a small town in rural Louisiana where the majority Black population is so light-skinned that one of the sisters passes as a white woman for most of her life after fleeing town. Americanah makes for a great read not only as an engaging and entertaining novel but also as a study about race in America from the perspective of a non-American Black person. Her first book in the mystery series that stars the Venetian police detective Guido Brunetti follows the investigation of a music conductor's death after he's poisoned during the intermission of a Verdi opera at La Felice. And while André Aciman's follow-up novel, Find Me, may leave hardcore fans of Elio and Oliver a little bit underwhelmed, there's nothing like going back to the original material. When the relatively unknown journalist Monique Grant is tasked with writing a profile on the legendary actress Evelyn Hugo, she can't believe her career-changing luck. As if all of that wasn't enough already, Less is on the brink of turning 50. The book is set in 2018 and there's constant chatter among its characters regarding Brexit and the Trump administration. So if you love the Venetian setting, crime stories and the constant descriptions of all the delicious foods (and drinks) that Brunetti ingests on a daily basis, this could definitely be the series for you. This story is so quintessentially Hollywood that there's a 1995 movie adaptation starring John Travolta and a 2017 TV show with Chris O'Dowd, but you should definitely start with the Elmore Leonard novel. Plus, there's a constant longing for a trip to Greece. He's trying to figure out his life in Tokyo in the 1960s and ends up in relationships with two women who couldn't be more different: there's Naoko, the former girlfriend of his best friend, and Midori, one of his classmates. — Agent Running in the Field is still worth a read if only to appreciate Le Carré's succinct yet masterfully rich and descriptive prose. And while Joan Lindsay's writing style and the setting for this novel may have you drawing some parallels with other classic coming-of-age novels written by and starring women, the ending of Picnic at Hanging Rock could only have been written in the 1960s. Liane Moriarty's soapy thriller still very much deserves a read.
